Discussion:

1. Use of training accounts after the training event is over –
 - Howard University Student – Linda will reach out copying Jay, NASA Scientist believed to be the students project leader, and Howard U Campus Champion; offer to assist with obtaining a startup; find out more about what he is doing; consider for a story
 - Spelman College Student – Also continued usage. Reaching out to her to be determined.
 - Capture for Impact statement the concept and individual stories – one to six month after training is a bit different than the longitudinal studies – discuss with Lorna
 - Routine checking the allocation usage after events is assigned to John to be done weekly. He will bring use to the CEE-BP calls for discussion and potential action.
